## Background and introduction

With growing urban population and changing household consumption patterns, waste management is fast becoming one of the key problems of modern society due to the ever-expanding volume and complexity of discarded domestic and industrial waste. Appropriate waste and resource management, under the right policy/business conditions, contributes to learning and development of capability, which in turn contributes to sound waste management practices. The session will address the status of solid waste policy promoting sustainable waste management in Turkey and the region. Further, the session will present potential solutions to the hurdles/challenges of waste management in Turkey and the region.

## Format

The event will start with a panel of four/five key note speakers, providing input for an informed and interactive discussion with the participants. The diversity of the panel members will ensure a comprehensive coverage of key aspects, including technical know-how, policy issues, financing and cases from the region. The format of the sessions will be a “Davos style” panel, with each panelist answering guiding/targeted questions by the moderator, followed by discussion in the panel and with the audience. The panel will have gender and geographical balance including local representatives from the region.

The event’s target audience are city and government representatives, national planning representatives, companies and persons working in the waste management sector, local, national and international organizations concerning environmental issues related to waste, advocacy groups, media and other visitors of the conference who are interested in waste management matters.
